- 5 Let me do right to all, and wrong no man.

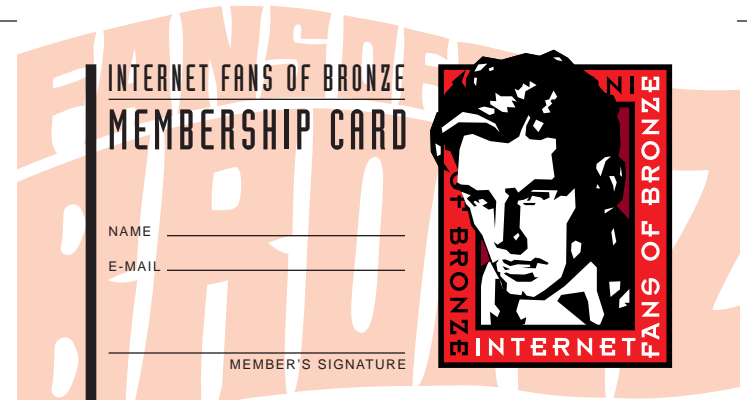

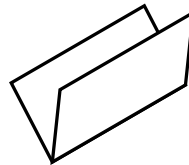

Two ways to  
create the  
cards!

**Print out once, then cut and fold over.**

Or better yet: fold over, gluing the back and front together, and then trim the card. Since glue can cause buckling of the paper, I suggest using twin-tack, which is a very thin two-sided adhesive that comes in large sheets with peel-off “backing” on both sides.



**Print two-sided on card stock.**

Print once. The left (old card) side should exit the printer before the right (new card) side. Flip the page over, vertically; When printing the second side, make sure that the left (old card) is again positioned to go through the printer first.
